What would I do?

1. Open & close the Miners Exchange Saloon Exhibit
2. Demonstrate for visitor the operations & history of the saloon
3. Sell sarsaparilla to thirsty visitors

What skills do I need?

1. Ability to talk with visitors
2. South Pass City Staff will train you!

What is the Schedule?

1. The exhibit is open Saturdays & Sundays – in June, July & August
2. 11 am to 3 pm
3. Take one day or take them all! You will be part of a team of volunteers.

What impact will I have?

The Miners Exchange Saloon is one of the oldest buildings in SPC. Saloons were the corner stones of the community. In 1868 there were 14 of them & only one church. The saloon is a hands on exhibit that lets visitors play billiards, have a hand of cards & sample a bit of sarsaparilla!
